

CPS 25th Anniversary Peony Show Schedule

The Canadian Peony Society's 25th AGM Peony Show will be an integral part of the 19th Annual Peony Festival, **June 10 & 11, 2023** at Children's Arena, 155 Arena Street, Oshawa.

Saturday June 10, 7:00 to 8:45am

The show will be judged:

Saturday June 10, 8:45 to 11:00am

Show open to public viewing:

Saturday June 10, 11:00am to 4:00pm
Sunday June 11, 10:00am to 4:00pm

SHOW SCHEDULE

Exhibitors will be asked to register with the Show Committee in the set-up area upon arriving.

1. The Show is open to any exhibitor who has grown the Peonies being shown.
2. An exhibitor can be an individual, a commercial Peony grower or a Botanical Garden.
3. All entries must be in place by 8:45 am Saturday, June 10, 2023.
4. Containers for specimen entries will be provided.
5. In each class you may place any number of different cultivars.
6. Each entry must have an entry tag attached including the class number, cultivar name and exhibitor name. Entry tags will be provided by CPS.
7. For this Show, please show Peonies with stems 12-14" with the top leaves only.
8. The decision of the Judges shall be final. The Judges may withhold an award if, in their opinion, the exhibit is not worthy.
9. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. "Best In Show" ribbons will be awarded in all divisions and one "Grand Champion" ribbon will be awarded.

DESIGN CLASSES

Design classes 2-8 are names of Peonies.

Class 2-5 Peonies were Registered with the APS in 1998 - the year CPS was formed.

The Canadian registrations were other years and are labeled with the Originator's name.

You do NOT need to use the Peonies named. They are to give you inspiration.

Foliage can be from any growing plant and other flowers may be included, but Peonies MUST dominate.
